


<b>Minutes of the meeting held on 10th July 2024 at the Ganolfan at 7 p.m.</b>

<b>1.</b>	<b>CHAIRMAN'S OPENING REMARKS AND APOLOGIES</b>	
	The meeting was formally opened by Councillor Gwilym Evans the Chair. Apologies were received from the following, Councillor Kim Jones, Councillor Trystan Thomas and Councillor Iwan Harding and Llinos Pritchard.	<b>CLERK</b>
1.1	No public participation	
1.2	Application to Vary Property License - Becws Melyn, Llanberis - the matter was discussed and it was decided to oppose the application on the grounds that there had been non-compliance with the current license and that complaints had been received about noise that disturbed nearby residents; also, opening the doors means that the noise can be heard more.	
1.3	Health and Safety - Councillor Emlyn Baylis had recently attended a health and safety course and stated that he had become more aware that some issues needed attention at the Centre, especially concerning the nursery. He was thanked for his comments and it was mentioned that the nursery would receive a visit from Care Inspectorate Wales.	
1.4	Traffic and parking in cul-de-sacs - it was said that Gwynedd Council's response to the problem was not satisfactory. It was decided that the Clerk would send correspondence on the matter again.	
1.5	Events at Coed y Ddol/Races - LLP - a complaint was received from a member of the public that events at Coed y Ddol were using Coed y Ddol to park vehicles instead of the designated area and that litter had been left. The Clerk to bring the matter to the attention of Padarn Park.	
1.6	Llyn Padarn - this matter was placed on the Council agenda by Councillor Kevin Jones, the issue was discussed and current information about the weeds was received. It was discussed whether it would be possible to set some kind of barrier around the weeds but the intention of Padarn Park is to lay hessian mats on top to smother it and then it will rot.	
1.7	Toilets - there had been complaints that the toilets close early in the afternoons and that the service is not available. The Clerk will send to the Borough Department at Gwynedd Council to ask	

	what service is provided for the annual fee that the Community Council pays.	
1.8	Condition of the roadside verges to Llanberis - complaints were received that the condition of the wall and the pavements on the way into the village is disgraceful with overgrowth - the matter was discussed and it was decided that the Clerk would send to Gwynedd Council.	
1.9	Bus Shelter Maes Padarn - the roof of the bus shelter needs restoration work. It was decided that the Clerk would search for and obtain a quote to carry out the work.	
1.10	A request was received from the Llanberis Development Group for funding to order leaflets. The matter was discussed and it was decided that £2500 was too much funding, but the council would be willing to contribute half. Unfortunately, Councillor Emlyn Baylis stated that the Group did not have the money to pay even half the cost and that they had not been able to raise banners around the village this year either. The Council decided to pay for raising banners for the village.

4.3	Memorial Sculpture of the Quarrymen - a work advancing to try to overcome problems with wires and underground services at the proposed location.	<b>CLERK</b>
4.4	HBO Panel - no follow-up since the panel meeting and receiving last month's minutes.	<b>CLERK</b>
4.5	Outdoor Gym - there has been no development on the matter for a while but a site meeting has been arranged to decide on the location.	
4.6	Menter/Partnership Llanberis - it will be necessary to arrange to invite groups and village societies to a special meeting. Councillor Rhys ap Gwilym and the Clerk to act on this.	<b>RhaG/CLERK</b>
4.7	Victoria Road and York Road - the Clerk said that she had been discussing the matter with Gwynedd Council and that discussions had been held between them and the National Park to work on	

	paths 9 and 10 in order to enable Snowdon walkers to use the paths especially at night. It is hoped to use the path that reaches the gate, this would also provide peace for the houses in Penceunant.
