

<b>4.8</b>	Walls up to the pass – there has been no positive response from Gwynedd or the Park. The matter has been raised by the County Councillor with a member of the National Park. Gwynedd Council has promised to send a road inspector to assess the situation, but no report has been received.	<b>GTE</b>
<b>4.9</b>	Parking – an explanation was given by the Clerk that changing the Parking Area in front of the Social Club over the Winter to long stay parking would have an impact because Gwynedd parking ticket dealers would be able to park there over the winter without paying; this meant that the spaces would be filled and that there would be little or no space available where people would need to pay, and this would mean a 10% contribution to the Council from the profit. Additionally, the parking area was changed to short stay at the request of the Community Council.	
<b>4.10</b>	HighwayMatters – a list was received from Gwynedd Council of the number and locations of the salt bins within the Community. It was noted on the list which ones needed to be filled regularly after use during severe weather. Some roads had several bins and some were not used. It was decided to move two from one road where there were several for a location near Dol Elidir and the other at the junction of Fron Goch and Tŷ Du Road.
