


Minutes of the meeting held on the 13th November 2024 at the Ganolfan at 7 p.m.

1.	CHAIRMAN'S OPENING REMARKS AND APOLOGIES

1.2	Financial Regulations Model - Received.	CLERK
1.3	Signs and Management of the Snowdonia Marathon - the inconvenience to the village due to the problems and thoughtless parking that occurs in residential areas within the village was discussed. The Clerk will send to the race organizers.	
1.4	Temporary roadworks on the A4086 by National Grid/Morgan Sindall after recent cable installation in the area opposite the junction leading to Siemens. - The matter was discussed and the Clerk was asked to write to Gwynedd Council to complain about the standard of work.	CLERK
1.5	Reference was made to the overgrowth of weeds on both sides of the A4086 from the tunnel to the village. The Clerk to send a complaint to Gwynedd Highways. Councillor Gwilym Evans to apply for the area to visit the area.	
1.6	Nant Peris Bus Stop - signs refer to the Sherpa Bus being crushed at the bus stop, also the same problem at Padarn Field. The Clerk to send to Gwynedd Council.	
1.7	Llanberis Signs - the plan to erect new signs within the village was considered as part of the development work for the slate heritage site. The majority of the Council opposed the plan and that those already on site are quite adequate. The intended ones do not suit the area. It only requires removing some from the poles and installing some new ones for new attractions. The Clerk to send a report and the Council's decision.	
1.8	Illegal signs and electric vehicle 'charging points' - these two issues were discussed together. It is suggested that people with electric vehicles who are getting electricity from home to the highway put	

	up signs to indicate that the area needs to be kept clear. These signs are not authorized.	
1.9	Community Project - this matter will be discussed at the next monthly meeting.	
1.10	Letter from a resident - presented for information. Councillor Gwilym Evans is dealing with it.	GTE

4.5	Outdoor Gym - two prices have been sent to Gwynedd Council for the work. No further information to present at this time.	CLERK
4.6	Menter/Partnership Llanberis Partnership Dyffryn Peris - a request had been received from the Dyffryn Peris Partnership to invite the Llanberis and Nant Peris Community Council to be a Core Partner. The request was considered following the decision made a few months ago to lead a Partnership Initiative specifically for Llanberis. It was decided that the Council would accept the invitation to be a core partner and that two Councillors would represent the Council, namely Councillor Bethan Holding and Councillor Rhys Ap Gwilym. 4.7	Bylaws - met with an officer from Gwynedd Council and saw that they could not issue an order to prohibit parking by vans in the lay-bys nor to enforce the order. The Council decided to look at introducing bylaws. Councillor Beth Holding will conduct research into the bylaws.	CLERK/BH
4.8	Walls up to the pass - no response from the National Park. Highways have requested an inspection from the road inspector.	GTE
