<b>1.</b>	<b>CHAIRMAN'S OPENING REMARKS AND APOLOGIES</b>	
	The meeting was officially opened by the Chair, Gwilym Evans. Apologies were received from the following, Councillor Aled Hughes. A report on county matters had been sent by the County Councillor in advance.	<b>CLERK</b>
<b>1.1</b>	Public participation took place. The issues were raised as items.	
<b>1.2</b>	Toilets - it seems that difficulties continues because they are not open in time in the mornings and they are closed too early in the evenings. The matter was discussed. Recent information was presented regarding the members helping to open the toilets early in the mornings open over the summer. It was suggested if it is possible to keep them open all day over the summer? the Clerk to make enquiries. Human waste is a problem because the toilets are closed, the possibility of installing a 'portaloo' near the bus parking area was requested. This matter was discussed and installing porta-loos was not practical, along with who would be responsible for them. Ensuring that toilets by the lake were open throughout the day was a better idea. There is a problem in the Glyn with the waste area for the vans, there is evidence that the vans are dropping papers and so on there. <b>1.4</b>	Sheep - request for a gate to be installed at Coed y Ddol that enables use by people who use wheelchairs. There is a need to know the latest information regarding the installation of a gate in the boundary wall of Coed y Ddol and First Hydro land. The Clerk to send to First Hydro and Padarn Park. Information regarding the SHEEP problem was presented. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. The Council recognizes that the sheep wandering in the village is a problem and sympathizes with residents who are affected by them due to noise and that they are destroying their gardens.</li> </ul>	<b>CLERK</b>

	<p>ii. The Council is in contact with Gwynedd Council (highways) regarding the problem. Arrangements are in place by the officers to investigate how they are accessing the village and to try to close the gaps in walls, fences, and so on.</p> <p>iii. The Community Council has an arrangement with a local shepherd to collect the sheep and return them to their owners.</p> <p>iv. If the sheep are on the highway, residents are asked to inform the police about this. Reporting the problem helps the case by getting a record of every incident.</p> <p>v. There is a plan to raise warning signs on the bypass to warn road users that sheep may be on the road for road safety.</p>

<b>3.0</b>	<b>CONFIRMATION OF EXPENDITURE AND FINANCIAL REPORTS</b>	
<b>3.1</b>	Expenditure for the months of April and May was presented along with financial reports for both months. Accepted.	
<b>3.2</b>	A request for funding was received from the Fetry to enable them to purchase new juggling equipment and new costumes. The Fetry will open the Juggling Olympics event in the summer. It was decided to grant them £400 under section 137 following a vote.	
<b>3.3</b>	HBO Money - Currently, £19204.96 of HBO money has been used for projects within the village. £17795.04 remains.	
<b>3.4</b>	CCTV - following a visit from North Wales Police concerning crime in the village and how installing a camera system within the village would help, it was decided that a system was needed in the village and that finding the best way to fund it was necessary. £30,000 has already been earmarked for purchasing land for a new cemetery, and because there has been difficulty finding land, it was decided that this money would now be allocated for the camera system. This will not be sufficient as the estimated cost for the system will be £50,000, so it was decided that the remaining money from the HBO funds would be used for this system. It is hoped that grants can also be found. HBO funding has been very beneficial, and because filming is taking place in the area again at the moment, it was decided to apply to them for funding for the benefit of the Community.	
<b>4.0</b>	<b>CONFIRMATION OF LAST MONTHS MINUTES AND MATTERS ARISING</b>	
<b>4.1</b>	Minutes for May 2025 were confirmed.	
<b>4.2</b>	The rubbish bin at Cae Chware Lan Llyn and Coed y Ddol. The bin has arrived and will be installed soon - no further information.	<b>CLERK</b>
<b>4.3</b>	Street Sculpture/Memorial to Quarrymen - this matter was considered along with other measures within the village following LLECHI funding in a recent meeting with Gwynedd officials. Finding a location for the sculpture has been a challenge, currently the only location is by the	<b>CLERK</b>

	Lake Shore, however discussions are ongoing between the Community Council and the Surgery to see if it is possible to erect it within the Community garden near the junction with the bypass. Discussions continue, another meeting has been arranged. There are new signs for the village, the signage plan has been receiving attention from Councillor Helen Sharp and Councillor Iola Owen to ensure that the information on them is correct. Councillor Gwilym Evans will meet with Gwynedd officials regarding the signs at the end of the week. Work to improve the pavements is progressing.	
<b>4.4</b>	Council Store - there has been no response yet from representatives of St John the Clerk to make contact again	<b>CLERK</b>
<b>4.5</b>	Outdoor Gym - the funds are expected to be received soon to implement the project. Need to arrange a site visit between Padarn Park, the Council, and the contractor.	<b>CLERK</b>
<b>5.0</b>	<b>HIGHWAYS AND PUBLIC FOOTPATHS</b>	
<b>5.1</b>	Path 17 is scheduled to receive maintenance work on the stile/gate by Gwynedd Council. We do not know who owns the land. The hedges along this path need to be cut. The Clerk is to arrange for this path to receive clearance work. It was decided to find out from the person who walks the paths on behalf of the Council which paths need to be cut.	<b>CLERK</b>
<b>5.2</b>	Gwynedd Council's response to the Meibion Bridge regarding the gate has been presented, and as a result, more information about the gates has been obtained. The one that needs attention is the one leading to the parking area. The Clerk is to send this information on.	
<b>5.3</b>	Crossing the road in Nant Peris - a verbal report was received that crossing in the village is dangerous. The matter was discussed and it was decided to apply to Gwynedd Council for a crossing. The Clerk to send to Gwynedd Council. Also, the speed within the village is high with recent data indicating this. It was decided that the Council would invest in having signs showing the speed of traffic. The Clerk to send to Gwynedd Council.
